

How Is Jasper Mountain Unique?

We take into consideration every aspect of the whole child. Children are immersed in a supportive “village” of adults and children who promote each other’s healing, growth and education in a beautiful and healthy setting. We have the latest in psychiatric, psychological and educational approaches as well as a setting that involves the children in a working family farm. The children participate in physical activities that include hiking, swimming, horseback riding, sports, and a jogging program. Other activities include music, art, drama and other expressive arts.

Areas of Specialization

Jasper Mountain has developed interventions that have proven to be effective with problems such as violent behaviors, sexual acting-out, emotional problems stemming from the effects of childhood trauma, fire-setting, serious difficulties attaching and bonding to others, and delayed social development. We have learned what works from experience and we implement new ideas continuously. We serve children between the ages of 4 - 13.

Academic Day Treatment

Our onsite-school is registered through the Oregon Department of Education in three categories: registered private school, an alternative to public school, and a special education provider. The services coordinated through our school program include all appropriate educational services for either regular or special education and any related services involved in meeting each child’s individual educational and mental health needs.

Equestrian Program

Our Equestrian Program is a highly impactful therapeutic tool for the children. The goal of this program is to teach our clients empathy and care through the interaction with animals. We have included horses in our program for over forty years. Our facilities include an indoor riding arena with excellent stables to house our equine family.

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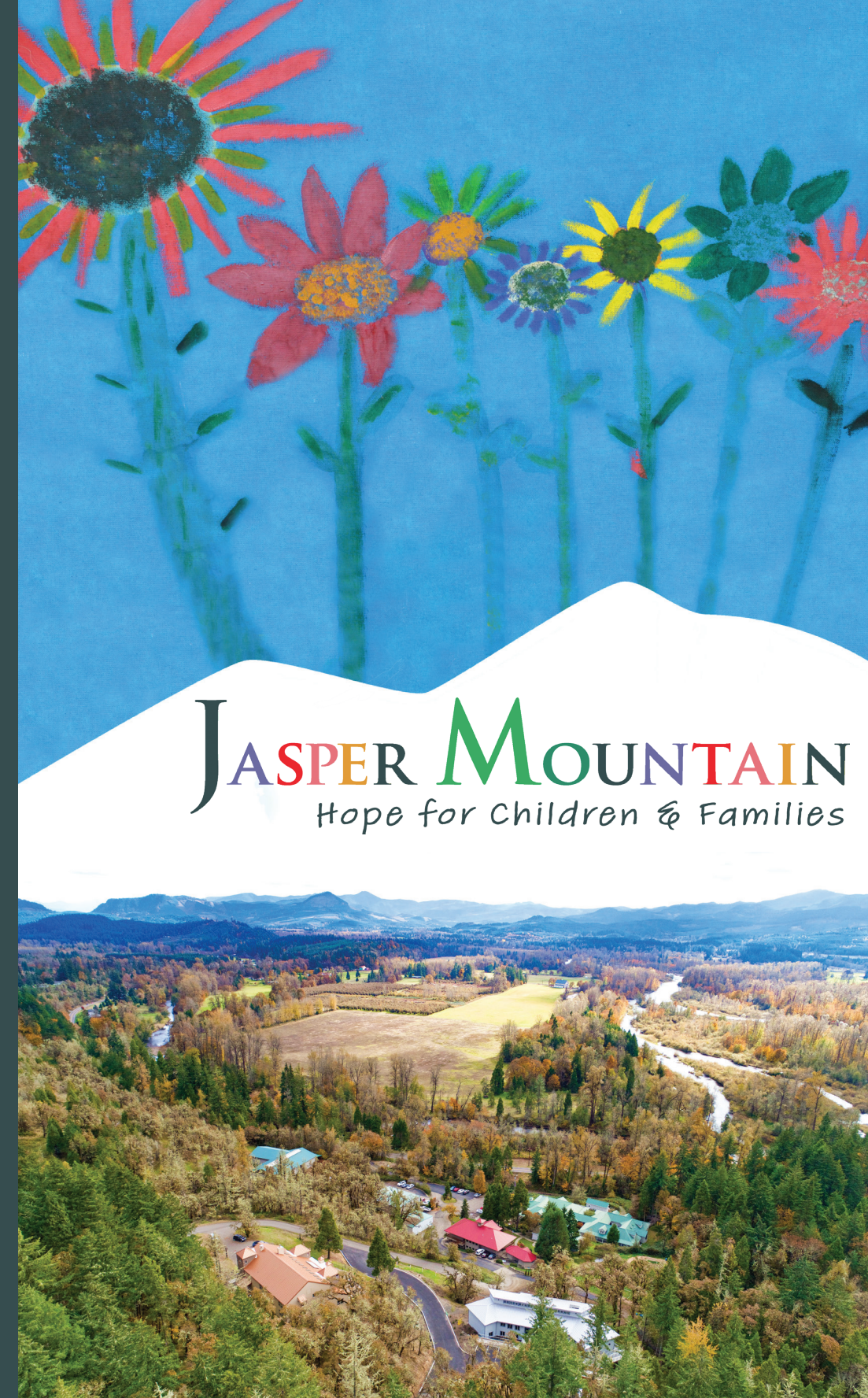

Jasper Mountain Center

Jasper Mountain Center is located on over ninety acres of Oregon forest. The program is twenty minutes from Eugene/Springfield and forty minutes from the Eugene airport. The property sits on the side of the mountain at the confluence of two rivers and includes streams, ponds and waterfalls.

THE CHILDREN’S CASTLE

Jasper Mountain is best known for the psychiatric residential treatment program that is housed in what is referred to as the Castle. Designed specifically for children who have experienced trauma, emotional and behavioral problems, the program combines relational treatment with helping children overcome their most challenging problems. Multiple evidence-based practices are utilized to create a holistic therapeutic environment.

Intensive therapy with psychiatrists, skilled therapists and direct care treatment staff are only a part of the program. The children participate in equine therapy, expressive arts, play therapy, group treatment and therapeutic recreation.



CRYSTAL CREEK

A second residential program on the Jasper Mountain Campus is Crystal Creek. This psychiatric residential treatment program is named after a creek on the property where the children find crystals. Like at the Castle, the residents live in a unique building – this one shaped like a diamond. Natural light flows throughout the building with partial glass floors between the first and second floors.

The focus of the program is preparing the children for a positive re-entry into a family as well as learning skills to succeed in the years ahead.

Both the Castle and Crystal Creek take advantage of the on-site school, train depot where psychiatric and psychological treatment takes place, equestrian center, gymnasium, playgrounds, running track and play field.



SAFE Center

Located in the beautiful Mohawk Valley, the SAFE Center is nestled in tall Douglas fir trees. The assessment and evaluation program is designed for children whose needs cannot be adequately evaluated in an outpatient setting and have struggled in family and school settings. In the short-stay residential program, the children go through a comprehensive evaluation. After evaluation, the program assists in placing the child in a setting for optimal success as they continue to develop and grow.

Children have adult supervision at all times at a staffing ratio of one adult to every three children. Staff are certified in crisis intervention to handle the most difficult and disruptive behavior.
