



## Gregory M. Ahlijian Scholarship

Scholarship Purpose: For students who have received treatment at a residential treatment institution in Oregon designed to address the effects of childhood abuse or neglect, or those who have been in foster care in Oregon.

### ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Must have:
  - received treatment at Jasper Mountain or other residential treatment institutions in Oregon
- OR***
- have been in foster care in Oregon
- Must have graduated high school or received the GED within the last 5 years
- Attending any public or private (nonprofit) college or university in the United States, including community college or an accredited trade school
- Enrolling at least half-time
- U.S. citizenship
- Financial need not required



### AWARD

- Renewable for up to 4 years; must reapply
